Scope of Notice

These California Privacy Disclosures supplement the Adams Street Privacy Notice with respect to specific rights granted under the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018, as amended, ("CCPA"), to natural person California residents and provides information regarding how such California residents can exercise their rights under the CCPA. These California Privacy Disclosures are only relevant to you if you are a resident of California as determined in accordance with the CCPA. Information required to be disclosed to California residents under the CCPA regarding the collection of their personal information that is not set forth in these California Privacy Disclosures is otherwise set forth in the Privacy Notice. To the extent there is any conflict with the privacy requirements under the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act and/or Regulation S-P ("GLB Rights"), GLB Rights shall apply.

Unless otherwise expressly stated, all terms in these California Privacy Disclosures have the same meaning as defined either in our Privacy Policy, Privacy Notice, or as otherwise defined in the CCPA.

Collection and Use of Sensitive Personal Information

We do not collect or use "sensitive personal" information other than:

- As reasonably necessary and proportionate to detect security incidents that compromise the availability, authenticity, integrity, and confidentiality of stored or transmitted personal information;
- As reasonably necessary and proportionate to resist malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal actions directed at us and to prosecute those responsible for such actions;
- For short-term, transient use (but not in a manner that discloses such information to another third party or is used to build a profile of you or otherwise alter your experience outside of your current interaction with us);
- To perform services on behalf of our business;
- To verify or maintain the quality or safety of a service or to improve, upgrade, or enhance such service or device; and
- To collect or process sensitive personal information where such collection or processing is

not for the purpose of inferring characteristics about a consumer.

Common Purposes for Collecting Personal Information

We may process or disclose the personal information we collect about you for one or more of the following business or commercial purposes:

- To facilitate our day-to-day business operations, including but not limited to: developing and monitoring private market investments, assisting investors in portfolio management and education, providing financial and accounting support, administering our Services, and providing tailored Services and information;
- The performance of our contractual and legal obligations (including applicable antimoney laundering, KYC and other related laws and regulations) in assessing an investor's suitability for investing in an investment vehicle;
- Ongoing communication with potential investors, their representatives, advisors and agents, (including the negotiation, preparation and signature of documentation) during the process of admitting potential investors to the relevant investment vehicle(s) and execution of relate documentation (*e.g.*, the subscription agreement);
- The ongoing administrative, accounting, reporting and other processes and communication required to operate our business and/or the relevant investment vehicle;
- To administer, manage and set up an account(s) to allow a potential investor to purchase a holding or interest in the relevant investment vehicle(s);
- To facilitate the execution, continuation or termination of the contractual relationship between an investor and the relevant investment vehicle (as applicable);
- To facilitate the transfer of funds, and administering and facilitating any other transaction, between an investor and the relevant investment vehicle;
- To audit and perform verifications related to investor interactions, including but not limited to, verifying the quality and effectiveness of services and compliance;
- To evaluate and review our business performance, conducting data analytics, determining the effectiveness of our marketing activities, identifying usage trends;
- To maintain the safety, security and integrity of our products and services, databases, technology assets and business, including to detect security incidents, and protect against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity;
- To enable any actual or proposed assignee or transferee of the investment vehicle (s), to evaluate proposed transactions;
- To facilitate investment transactions, including any business asset transactions involving the relevant investment vehicle;
- To enforce and carry out contracts and agreements;
- To fulfil any legal or regulatory requirement;
- Keeping investors informed about our business generally; and
- Any other purpose that has been notified, or has been agreed, in writing.

We retain the categories of personal information set forth above in the "Categories of Personal Information We Collect" section of these California Privacy Disclosures only as long as is reasonably necessary for those purposes set forth above, except as may be required under applicable

law, court order or government regulations.

Disclosure of Personal Information

We do not share for the purpose of cross-context behavioral advertising or sell (as such terms are defined in the CCPA) any of the personal information we collect about you to third parties.

Your California Privacy Rights

If we request you verify your request and we do not receive your response, we will pause processing your request until such verification is received.
